To All Interested Parties:

Waukesha County Department of Public Works, along with their engineering consultant Ayres Associates, is evaluating alternatives for the replacement of the CTH YY (Pilgrim Road) Structure over Underwood Creek in the City of Brookfield. A project location map is enclosed. The project is being completed with county funds. Construction is currently scheduled for 2020.

The existing roadway over the creek crossing will remain two-lanes but 10-foot shoulders will be added on each side with the project. Land acquisition for the ultimate 120-foot right-of-way along the corridor is anticipated, and additional right-of-way or easements may be required.

You are invited to attend a **Public Information Meeting** for the CTH YY (Pilgrim Road) Structure over Underwood Creek project to be held on **Wednesday, February 13, 2019 from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the City of Brookfield Public Safety Building**, located at 2100 North Calhoun Road, Brookfield, WI 53005. The meeting will be held in the **Courtroom**.
